Memorandum of Understanding

Saturday, September 29, 2012

Michigan Specialized Communications Group, Inc. (MSCG) and Genesee County Radio Club (GCRC) have come together to collaborate on the operation and use of the **147.340 MHz repeater** during emergency nets; and the partners herein desire to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding setting forth the services to be provided by the collaborative.

Short description

The intent of this document is to put into writing the gentlemen's agreement that has existed for decades between MSCG Inc (formerly GCARES) and GCRC. It is agreed that MSCG Inc. will be able to use the GCRC Repeater as a secondary backup in the event that both of the MSCG repeaters fail, or are unable to provide adequate communications.



Roles and Responsibilities

- MSCG Inc. understands that MSCG its associated divisions are able to use the GCRC Repeater for emergency nets in a situation where time constraints make it impractical to secure permission first.
- MSCG Inc. further understands that GCRC will continue to make their repeater available for public service and social use, provided that permission has been secured from the GCRC Board ahead of time.
- GCRC understands that they are the secondary backup repeater system for ARES operations in Genesee County, in the event that the 147.26 is unable to provide adequate communications.
- GCRC understands that this agreement applies in-reciprocal with MSCG, Inc.
- MSCG Inc.'s divisions include Genesee County Amateur Radio Public Service Corps and Genesee County Search and Rescue

This Agreement

- This agreement will remain in effect indefinitely from Saturday, September 29, 2012, until canceled in writing by either party.
